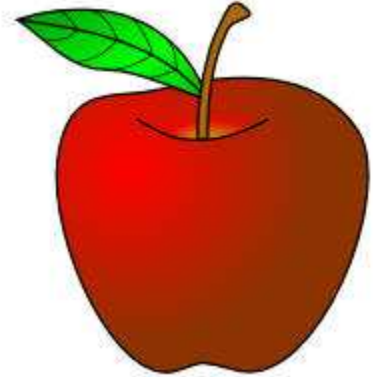


Opening Day of Religious School For Parents
